



Volunteer Grounds Steward Role Description

Friends of Bank Hall hold approximately 10 outdoor Events during the year which can include Snowdrop Walks, Daffodil Day, Easter Bunny Hunt, Heritage Days, Autumn Animal Trail, National Tree Day. The work of the Volunteer Events Team is varied and vital to support income generation and the enjoyment of visitors to Bank Hall.

Main Focus of work can include:

- Assist in setting up pathway signage
- Rake any pathway molehills that appear
- Remove any pathway debris/litter
- Ensure visitors keep to woodchip pathways
- Answer visitor enquiries as appropriate
- If time allows before visitors arrive, assist in setting up/dismantling gazebos, furniture and equipment
- This role is potentially interchangeable with the Parking Steward role (and subject to written guidelines on parking)

Desirable Qualities:

- Enjoy working outdoors and being part of a team
- Have a flexible manner in undertaking varied tasks
- Possess a reasonable level of fitness
- Able to demonstrate good communication skills

Information and Terms:

- Volunteers mainly work Sundays, with occasional Saturdays/Wednesdays
- Volunteers arrive at 9.30am to assist with set up and finish about 4pm (bringing their own lunch, however we appreciate you may not be able to offer the whole day)
- Comfortable clothing and footwear should be worn, weather dependent
- Hi-Viz vests are provided for Grounds Stewards on event days
- All Volunteers receive an induction and training as appropriate
- Event Volunteers are required to observe our Health & Safety and Volunteer policies
