

## Code of Practice in Respect of Dogs in the Grounds of Bank Hall

The Friends of Bank Hall wish that all our visitors enjoy the beauty and tranquillity of the Pleasure Grounds at Bank Hall.

If you are visiting the grounds today with your dog we ask that you follow our code of practice.

- Keep your dog on a short lead at all times. **Leads that extend are not permitted.**
- Keep to the designated paths within the grounds.
- Do not allow your dog to jump up at other visitors particularly those with small children.
- Pick up any 'poo' that your dog makes in a bag and deposit in the local dog 'poo' bins on nearby public roads in Bretherton or on your return home.
- When outdoor theatre/music events are being held dogs will not be allowed in the grounds.
- Dogs may not be allowed in the Grounds at certain other events. This may be due to the volume of children present or for other reasons. In certain cases, admittance may be at the discretion of a Committee Member.
- Dogs will not be permitted in the Coach House block or other buildings that The Friends of Bank Hall are occupying.
- Please respect members of The Friends of Bank Hall recognisable by their uniform fleeces and ID badges. They will patrol the grounds during open days.

Where appropriate, Assistance Dogs are excepted.

For your convenience short leads and dog 'poo' bags are available from Hoggs Hut at the entrance to the grounds.

We want you and your dog to enjoy the visit today and return again !

Bowls of water for your dog will be located at the entrance to the grounds.
