## **Editorial**

As mentioned in the last News Sheet, we were not able to open for the Snowdrop Season again in February but this year it was due to the 3rd Covid Lockdown. ## Easter Sunday – 4th April

With the lockdown rules easing on the 28th March, we are planning on opening the grounds on Easter Sunday. The daffodils are now coming out and we hope they are still there at Easter. There will be no catering as this will not be permitted under the rules until later in April. Also we are not having any activities or stalls but this will be an opportunity for visitors to see the completed restored Hall externally although the fencing may still be surrounding the Hall. ### Western Approaches Museum in Liverpool

February 17th was the 80th Anniversary of the Western Approaches Control Centre in Liverpool. The Western Approaches Control was a Royal Navy and RAF combined HQ set up because German aircraft and U-boats were attacking ships travelling in to the UK. Western Approaches Control monitored shipping approaches in the rectangular area of the Atlantic Ocean lying immediately to the west of the British Isles.

We know that Bank Hall was requisitioned by the Royal Engineers, Movement Control under the War Office during World War II as the control centre for north west ports. This was for the movement of all war department stores (ammunition, tanks etc.) being shipped overseas to theatres of war.

We contacted the Western Approaches Museum to enquire if there was a link with the wartime operation that took place at Bank Hall. They were not aware of any direct link between Bank Hall and the Western Approaches Control although this is not to say that there wouldn't have been some link at least, so further research is required to establish this.
